Rock climbing can be a dangerous activity. The National Park Service does not maintain climbing routes or associated climbing gear and cannot guarantee your safety. You climb at your own risk; helmets are advised.

Be considerate, ask permission if you wish to climb in a campsite that is occupied.

Chipping, scraping, gardening, comfortizing, and gluing holds is prohibited. Minimize the use of chalk on boulder problems and brush off chalk after boulder sessions to minimize the visual impact.

Slack lines are not permitted in campgrounds.
